

Public Transportation to New Brunswick, NJ

1. **From Newark Liberty International Airport (EWR):**

Take the AirTrain to Newark Airport New Jersey Transit Terminal, then take the Northeast Corridor Line to New Brunswick (njtransit.com). Make sure the train stops at New Brunswick as some might skip it during rush hours. If you prefer to take a taxi, there is a taxi stand outside the airport. The fee is known before entering the taxi (it is not a metered taxi).

2. **From JFK:**

Take the subway (A or E) to Penn Station, New York, and then take the New Jersey Transit (Northeast Corridor Line: njtransit.com) to New Brunswick.

3. **From LaGuardia:**

Take taxi or public transportation (www.mta.info) to Penn Station, New York, and then take the New Jersey Transit (Northeast Corridor Line: njtransit.com) to New Brunswick.

The [Hedrich Hotel](#) is a short walk from the New Brunswick train station on George Street.
